

Refer to <u>Control Module References</u>.</li> <li>When replacing the communication interface module be sure to transfer the Bluetooth antenna, if equipped.</li> </ol>
	Tip The vehicle communication interface module (VCIM) has a specific set of unique numbers that tie the module to each vehicle. These numbers, the 10-digit station identification and the 11-digit electronic serial number, are used by the National Cellular Network and On State and the these series of the second series of the second secon
